

INSTALLATION GUIDE

OVERVIEW

The Cinema Bar 3.0 passive soundbar is the perfect on-wall soundbar solution to pair with the Russound AVA-Series of mini-AVRs to improve the sound of any audio content, whether it be music, TV shows, or even the most dramatic cinematic moments of your favorite movies.

The large 4" polypropylene woofers with their passive radiator design for bass enhancement will provide you with sound that you never would have thought possible without a dedicated subwoofer in the room.

Constructed of reinforced MDF with isolated audio chambers for each channel, the stylish satin black soundbar adds elegance and appeal beneath the television.

OVERVIEW

The Russound Cinema Series is designed to enhance the enjoyment of any audio system through the use of the highest quality audio components in a custom-optimized enclosure that looks good in any home environment. The premium woofers combined with their passive radiators enhance the bass response to levels that you would never expect in such a low-profile soundbar.

RECOMMENDED AMPLIFIER POWER

The Cinema Bar 3.0 is designed to handle up to 100 watts RMS per channel.

INSTALLATION OPTIONS

The Cinema Bar 3.0 is designed to be either wall-mounted or attached to a TV mount. It includes our easy-to-use adjustable slide brackets as well as built-in key-hole slots. For TV mounting, it has built-in 1/4-20 threaded inserts to use with most TV soundbar mounting kits (sold separately).


WALL MOUNTING

The Cinema Bar 3.0 may be mounted on any wall or other flat surface using the included wall-mount slide brackets. Make sure to use suitable wall-anchors or secure the brackets to any wall stud.

Before beginning a wall-mounting installation, make sure to plan the location carefully to avoid any electrical, plumbing, HVAC, or other possible obstacles behind the wall.

The soundbar should be as close to the TV as possible for an ideal listening experience. Separating the soundbar from the TV too much can lead to a poor listening experience with the audio content separating from the video content.

USING A TV/SOUNDBAR MOUNT:



For optimal performance, attach the Cinema Bar 3.0 to your TV mount using the built-in threaded inserts which are spaced 16-1/2" (41.91cm) apart. This is compatible with most 3rd party soundbar mounting kits.

MOUNTING YOUR SOUNDBAR ON THE WALL WITH THE INCLUDED BRACKETS:


The included wall-mount brackets are designed with a unique slide adjustment capability, allowing the mounted soundbar to slide from left to right a maximum of approximately 5" (12.7cm) after the soundbar is mounted.

If the brackets are mounted in the center of their mounting slots, this means that the soundbar can be adjusted horizontally for approximately 2.5" (6.4cm) in either direction.

The brackets should be separated by 25-3/16" (64cm) on the wall, center to center, for optimum spacing.

When fully mounted, the center of the top screwholes of the wall-mount brackets will be 2.5" (6.4cm) from the top edge of the Cinema Bar 3.0. We recommend separating the Cinema Bar 3.0 from the bottom edge of the TV by at least $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm).

- 1. Choose a suitable wall location
- 2. Mark the locations of the wall-mount bracket screw-holes
- 3. Secure the brackets to the wall. Use suitable anchors if needed
- 4. Attach the soundbar to the brackets by inserting the bottom edge of the bracket to the soundbar first and then tilting the soundbar onto the top angled portion of the brackets
- 5. Test and ensure a stable mount. The soundbar can be adjusted left-to right to ensure exact alignment




MOUNTING YOUR SOUNDBAR ON THE WALL WITH THE KEYHOLE SLOTS:

The Cinema Bar 3.0 can be mounted using the built-in keyhole slots.

For a $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm) separation from the bottom edge of the TV when mounted, locate the screws 1.97" (5 cm) below the edge of the TV. The two screws will be separated by 25-3/16" (64cm) center to center.


- 1. Choose a suitable wall location
- 2. Mark the locations of the screw-holes
- 3. Secure the screws to the wall. Use suitable anchors if needed
- 4. Attach the soundbar to the screws using the keyhole slots
- 5. Test and ensure a stable mount



CONNECTING THE SOUNDBAR

CONNECTIONS

This diagram displays connections with the AVA3.1 unit connected to the left, center, and right channels of the Cinema Bar 3.0. An HDMI cable connects the TV to the AVA3.1, streamlining the audio-visual setup.



CONNECTING LOUDSPEAKERS

Note: All wiring connections must be made with the amplifier powered off

As with any premium loudspeaker, the Cinema Bar 3.0 should always connect directly to the amplifier. CL2-rated wire, or any specific wire specifications required by local electrical codes must be used when running wire within a home's walls. The premium built-in push connectors are designed to use up to 12 ga wire. Stranded wire is recommended for all installations. The oversized terminal area on the rear of the Cinema Bar 3.0 is designed to minimize installation time while allowing the soundbar to sit flush to the wall.

When connecting the loudspeaker wires, be sure to observe proper polarity. The positive and negative terminals for each channel (left, right, and center) must correspond with the positive and negative terminals on the amplifier.

Strip 1/8" (about 3mm) from each of the conductors for left, right, and center and insert them into the proper push terminal, making sure to match the

proper polarity of each connection. Make sure that there are no exposed strands that might cause a short-circuit.

CARE

Remove dust with a microfiber cloth. Chemicals or solvents should not be used as they can affect the finish. The grille is removable by pulling gently to separate the push-mounting pins from their mounting holes. Pull gently around the edge, moving from one side to another until the grille is fully removed.
